They absolutely can be used, we prefer used, please don't go purchase brand new, we can purchase brand new with our funds if we need to, but are hoping to find some that folks are not using and willing to donate.
 - 2-3 Crockpots 6 Quart and larger. Liner needs to be removable for easy washing.
 - 2 Large Stock Pots with lids – 16 quarts
 - 20 Large, 12x12 ceramic or stone tiles – any color
 - 2 Can Openers
 - 2 Metal Whisks
 - Several large containers for leftovers. –Examples: Ice cream buckets, Large Sour Cream or cottage cheese containers, glass containers that can be reheated.
