

PENNINGTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
Meeting of January 3, 2023

The Pennington County Board of Commissioners met at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, January 3, 2023, in the Commission Chambers in the County Administration Building, Rapid City, South Dakota. Chair Gary Drewes called the meeting to order with the following Commissioners present: Deb Hadcock, Lloyd LaCroix, Travis Lasseter and Ron Rossknecht.

OATHS OF OFFICE

Honorable Judge Craig Pfeifle administered the oath of office to Commissioner Ron Rossknecht. Auditor Cindy Mohler administered the oath of office to Commissioner Deb Hadcock. Treasurer Janet Saylor administered the oath of office to Commissioner Gary Drewes.

ELECTIONS OF OFFICERS

Rossknecht nominated LaCroix for Chair. Drewes seconded the nomination even though seconds are not required for nominations.

Hadcock nominated Lasseter for Chair.

The vote was taken in the order of the nominations made. Vote: The vote for Commissioner LaCroix for Chair carried 3-2 with Hadcock and Lasseter voting no.

Hadcock nominated Lasseter for Vice-Chair.

Drewes nominated Rossknecht for Vice-Chair. Rossknecht seconded the nomination.

The vote was taken in the order of the nominations made. Vote: The vote for Commissioner Lasseter for Vice-Chair failed 2-3 with Drewes, LaCroix and Rossknecht voting no. Vote: The vote for Commissioner Rossknecht for Vice-Chair carried 3-2 with Hadcock and Lasseter voting no.

AND, the person delivering the pollbooks and ballot boxes to the proper authority at the county seat shall receive the county rate for mileage as established pursuant to § [7-7-24](#), for miles necessarily traveled in going to and returning from making the delivery.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE Pennington County Board of Commissioners, that the fee paid in the year 2023 to the precinct superintendent be established at \$275, which includes \$30 for election school; the precinct deputy with experience at \$225, which includes \$30 for election school; and, the precinct deputy without experience at \$200, which includes \$30 for election school. The Absentee Precinct Superintendent is paid \$15 per hour, the Absentee Precinct Board Deputy is paid \$12.50 per hour.
