- With plans rolled out for virtual options for TLC and Performing Arts, the South Dakota 4-H Leaders will offer scholarships to assist with the cost of the camps.

- There is a \$25 scholarship available for 4-H'ers who attend TLC (registration cost is \$60). There is a \$50 scholarship available for 4-H'ers who attend Performing Arts (registration cost is \$150). Here is how the scholarship program works.
 - Step 1 – Register for the 2020 camp and pay the full camp fees.
 - Step 2 – Attend virtual camp and have a great time!!
 - Step 3 – Tell one group about camp.
 - Step 4 – Complete the camp assistance/scholarship application form with all signatures and submit to the SD 4-H Leaders. Electronic signatures are acceptable, and the completed form may be scanned and emailed or mailed. You will receive your scholarship money within 2 weeks of its receipt. Applications are due by December 31, 2020.
 - **Please be sure to complete all parts of the form! You must answer the “what did you learn” section and sign it!**

- Clubs/Leaders should be working on obtaining an EIN number if they have not already and start working on their tax process for the year – If you need help with this please contact me via email. **THIS DATE HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO JULY 15th!**
- **You need to have all of your project areas entered into 4-Honline by June 1st. (Project Areas and **ANIMALS must be entered into 4-H Online by June 1st – so dogs, horses, rabbits... etc., all animals need entered.**)**

- If you did not get your rodeo information entered by the original deadline, you will need to have it entered by June 1st with your late fee included.

- **4-H Online**
 - You may find you have more down time than normal at this point. This is the perfect opportunity to start entering animals and projects into 4-H Online! You have until June 1st at 11:59pm to upload your information.
 - You have until July 1st at 11:59pm to enter Registration Papers, YQCA or Companion Animals.
- **YQCA**
 - How to upload your YQCA Certificate into 4-H Online
 1. Go to WWW.YQCA.ORG
 2. Select SD 4-H Youth Development
 3. Log in using 4-H Online credentials
 4. Select the youth you are looking for
 5. Click on Completed Credit Tab
 6. Click on Print Certificate
 7. Save File As
 8. Login to www.4Honline.com and up load file to one of the animals registered under that youth.
